実務経験の内容, 及び当該授業への実務経験の活かし方 / Instructor's practical experience and how it is utilized for this course	<p>As a full-time employee and director of some NGOs, I have long been involved in their administration and projects such as production of teaching materials and textbooks, development of programs and curriculum, planning and operation of various workshops and seminars for experts and citizens in the fields of development education, global education, and education for sustainable development (ESD) and so on. The content and the plan of this lesson is formulated being based on knowledge and experiences gained through these practical work and field studies. 授業の内容 / Course Description	<p>In this course, we learn and discuss about what "globalization" is and what have been going on in this global society. This course introduces some basic ideas of "globalization" and "global issues" in local and global communities. Also, through some group works and workshops, some participatory learning skills of global education will be introduced so that we can understand those global issues and take actions for our common future.</p> <p>This course is double-coded with the common course "Globalization and Society" of the Graduate School of Regional Development and Creativity. 学習上の助言 / Learning Advice	この授業は、将来、海外留学をはじめ、海外でのインターンシップやボランティア活動などを考えているけれども、「英語には自信がない人」を主な対象にします。英語による講義や議論、グループワークに慣れながら、地球社会が直面する問題を英語で理解し、自分の意見やアイデアを英語で発表することを目指します。したがって、必要とされる英語力は初級レベルで結構です。英語が得意な人の履修も歓迎しますが、授業の趣旨や授業で使う英語のレベルを理解した上での履修をお願いします。 なお、授業内で紹介するワークショップは、基盤教育科目の「ワークショップで学ぶ変わりゆく現代社会の中の私たち」や国際学部専門科目「グローバル教育論」で紹介したワークショップと一部重複することがあります。
